### DORSET JUNIOR KNOCKOUT 2009

#### COMPETITION RULES

Each team is to consist of six players and each match is to be played as **singles in handicap order**. No caddies are permitted. Players must be under 18 years of age on the 1<sup>st</sup> January 2009 and hold a **CONGU Handicap**, limits for the competition are **Boys 28, Girls – 36** played off **full handicap difference**.

Players may represent only **one club in any competition season**, if a member of more than one club, the 'home' club will have first call on the initial selection. **If a club as entered two team's players may only represent one of those teams.**

One point is to be awarded for a win and a half point if the match is level after eighteen holes. Should teams be tied on points after the completion of both legs, the match is to be decided by the first named players in the second leg playing sudden death starting from the first tee.

The result sheet at the completion of both legs of the match is to be completed by both managers and sent back to the County Secretary.

In the event of any dispute the decision of a County official shall be final. Unresolved disputes are to be forwarded to the County Secretary.

Junior Organisers are to ascertain the dress rules of the Club they are due to play and ensure all players have been advised accordingly. Visiting players are asked to respect all rules of the Home Club.

All matches should be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R & A Golf Club of St Andrews, and Byelaws and local rules of the host Club.

Meals are optional and if provided each club should pay for their own unless otherwise agreed.

#### Semi Finals and Final – Canford Magna GC on Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> August 2009

The semi-final matches will be played in the morning over one leg in handicap order. The semi final matches will alternate from the first tee to allow the Final to begin sooner. There will be no play-off for 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> place.

Lunch will be provided for all players.

The Winning team will go forward to represent the County in the Area Finals.
