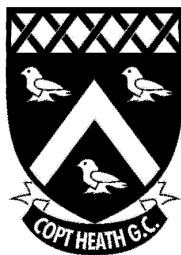

BOYS OPEN STROKE PLAY TOURNAMENT 72 Hole Medal Play (Scratch)

THE 32nd PETER McEVOY TROPHY Wednesday 18th & Thursday 19th April 2012

The competition will be played over 72 holes. All competitors will play the first 36 holes on Wednesday 18th April 2012. The leading 40 competitors (and all tying for 40th place) will play the final 36 holes on Thursday 19th April 2012. The final qualifiers will play in the reverse order of score achieved in the first 36 holes. Both first and tenth tees will be utilised; on Wednesday 18th April (playing in 3s) those starting from 1st tee in round 1 will play from 10th tee in round 2 and vice versa; and on Thursday 19th April (playing in 2s) those starting from 1st tee in round 3 will commence from 10th tee in the round 4 and vice versa.

In the event of a tie for the Peter McEvoy Trophy the result will be decided by 'sudden death' play-off starting at the 18th hole, utilising holes 18, 9 and 1. All other places will be decided on the combined score for all four rounds; if scores are still tied they be equally placed.

The organising Committee's decision on any matter relating to the event is final.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Entries are invited from boys of amateur status who are under the age of 18 years at 00.00 hours on 1st January 2012, with a certified active playing handicap of 2 and under.
2. Entries must be countersigned by the player's Club Secretary
3. Entries will be limited to 72 players. In the event of applications exceeding this number, entries for the higher handicap competitors shall be decided by ballot, which shall take place immediately after the closing date for entries.
4. **The CLOSING DATE IS, 12.00 NOON, Wednesday 21st March 2012.**

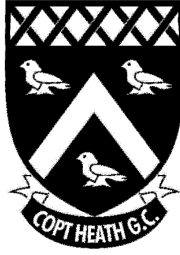
PRIZES

GENERAL INFORMATION AND ENTRY FORM

1. STARTING SHEETS

These will be emailed to all accepted competitors immediately following the draw and also on the Copt Heath G C website www.coptheathgolf.co.uk . In the event of any competitor having to withdraw he should notify the Secretary of Copt Heath Golf Club immediately by telephone (01564 731620), email golf@copt-heath.co.uk or facsimile (01564 731621). The Competition Committee reserves the right to fix and/or alter starting times.

2. PRACTICE AND REGISTRATION

A courtesy practice round, for competitors only, will be allowed on Tuesday 17th April, when players will be required to register, in the Professional's Shop, before playing. Any competitor unable to register should inform the Club Secretary. Competitors are required to pre-book a starting time with the Professional (01564 731623).

3. DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES

Those devices, which measure distance only, may be used during the competition. (Rule 14.3 applies).

4. DRESS

Smart casual dress may be worn throughout the Clubhouse at all times. However, those competitors attending the prize presentation would be expected to wear Jacket and Tie. Jeans and tracksuits are not suitable wear on the Course or in the Clubhouse.

5. MEALS

Meals and snacks will be available at standard Club prices. Meals may be taken on the first floor, subject to dress requirements, but hot and cold snacks including soup may be taken in the Stud Bar on the ground floor.
