36 Hole Stroke Play off Scratch. (Handicap limit 12)

The "Ruttle" Challenge Cup – to be held for one year, and a Silver Medal will be awarded to the competitor returning the best Scratch score over 36 holes. He will be the County Boy's Champion.

The "Kingsley Whiffen" Memorial Cup – to be held for one year, by the competitor under the age of 16 on the 1st January 2012 returning the best Scratch score over 36 holes. He will be the County Boy's Under 16 Champion.

The "Weymouth" Challenge Cup - to be held for one year, awarded to the competitor returning the best Net score over the morning 18 hole round. He will be the County Boy's Handicap Champion

Team Championship – A club may be represented by teams of not more than 3 players who must be declared to the Secretary before 10a.m. on the morning of the Championship. The club whose team records the lowest aggregate of two scratch scores from three over the morning 18 holes shall be the Team Champions. The Club will go forward to represent the County in the EGU Junior Champion Club event at Woodhall Spa 25-26 Aug 12.

The Championship will be played over 36 hole strokeplay, a cut will be made after 18 holes and the number of players going into the final round will be decided by the committee who will take into consideration weather, pace of play, scoring and available tee times. If no under 16 entrant qualifies for the last 18 holes the top 6 under 16's will play the additional 18 holes to decide the Under 16 Champion. In the event of a tie or ties, decision will be by reference to the best score for the last 18, 9, 6 or 3 holes etc.

Entry limited to 60 players, handicap limit 12, balloting out by handicap To compete in the Championship a player must be of Amateur Status as defined by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews, must not have taken part in a County Championship of another County Union or have represented another County Union at golf in the 12 months previous to the starting date of the event in question, must be under 18 on the 1 January 2012 and conform to the handicap limits which are included in the regulations of the event, and must be a member of a Member Club or must be born in Dorset and be a member of a Club affiliated to another County Union.
