CONDITIONS – PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

1. On presentation of this signed card to the Secretary, Manager or Official of any of the Clubs printed on the card pages, the Member is entitled to play on the course **once** during the year (except on such days as the Course is required for the purposes of the Club) upon payment which within the South West region will be 50% of the day rate green fee, otherwise the reduction in fees allowed is at the prerogative of the hosting club.

2. The Official of the Club which the Member is visiting must strike through the name of the Club on the Card. A record must be made by that Club of the Member's name, the number of the Card and the Date of the Visit.

3. Before visiting a Club, the Member **MUST** confirm with the Club Secretary or Professional **during office hours** and at least 72 hours in advance so as to ensure it convenient to play as a Card holder on a particular day, and ascertain the reduced fee payable. ***You may be refused play if you just turn up and expect to play. Please visit the County Web site of the club you intend to visit to check if any restrictions apply.***

4. It is understood that by subscribing to the County Membership Scheme, the Member undertakes to observe carefully the Rules and Regulations and any current Local Rules of the Club being visited.

5. Certain Clubs restrict visits while an Open Meeting or Club Competition is in progress and, in other Clubs, the time when visitors are allowed to start play. Play may also be restricted on Courses near holiday centres during the summer period.

6. Only one County Membership Card can be issued to a Member, irrespective of the number of affiliated Clubs of which he is a Member.
