In the afternoon the heavens opened, Matt Walker leading out the County was 5 down after 5 but a quite word from the captain saw him battle back to obtain a half. Mike Evans making his county debut played steadily and finished with two birdies to win 2 up. In between bouts of sunshine both Jon Welch and Cory Coshan played some really good golf winning their matches 7/6 and 5/4 respectively. Kevin Robinson who played as a reserve won his game with some accurate iron play
