Dave Cook played some consistent golf against a difficult opponent but ran out a 2/1 winner. However Dorset's middle order did not play to their full potential and all lost their games despite promising starts.

Tom Leech and Giles Legg both played particularly well running out 4/3 winners but Surrey won the tie overall 8 – 4.
